## **CONFIDENCE IN CHRIST (PHILIPPIANS 1:6)**

<u>Introduction:</u> Faith in God gives the Christian a special kind of confidence that would not exist otherwise.

- I. <u>Confidence in God reveals</u> itself in boldness.
  - A. In the Old Testament, Solomon spoke of boldness being a characteristic of the righteous man. (Proverbs 28:1)
  - B. Our Lord Jesus Christ was bold in the eyes of other people. (John 7:25-26)
  - C. "If you can't be bold, act bold the results will be the same."
- II. Christian confidence is centered on the great work of salvation.
  - A. Jesus started a work in us when we trusted Him as Savior.
    - 1. It is a work of God's grace. (Ephesians 2:8)
    - 2. It is a work that produces good works in us. (Ephesians 2:10)
    - 3. It is a work of reconciliation with God. (Ephesians 2:16)
  - B. Paul is confident that God's grace will work in his life.
    - 1. Personal failure cannot destroy God's grace in your life.
    - 2. God will work thru your failures if you acknowledge Him.
- III. Paul is confident in a hopeless situation.
  - A. Paul knows that he is about to die.
  - B. He knows that he didn't start this work God did.
  - C. He knows this work is "in you."
    - 1. Salvation does not merely make us a little better than we were before.
    - 2. Salvation changes us form the inside out.
  - D. The word "perform" suggests that we are God's theater, and the world is watching us.
  - E. "until the day of Jesus Christ."

- 1. Not the days of our death, but the day of Jesus Christ.
- 2. God finishes what He begins.

<u>Conclusion:</u> We have Great Confidence in a Great God to do Great Things in His name.
